





Programming Courses



- Course Start Number:
 - 1st year or Grade 10 courses start with the number 1 (for example, 10, 15)
 - 2nd year or Grade 11 courses start with the number 2 (for example, 20, 25)
 - 3rd year or Grade 12 courses start with the number 3 (for example, 30, 35)
- Course Sequence Number (Science 10-1 vs 10-2):
 - Course sequences ending in -1 emphasize abstract and conceptual challenges
 - Course sequences ending in -2, -3, and -4 do include abstract challenges, but they emphasize increasingly concrete and practical challenges
- Math 10C (combined -1 & -2) , 10-3 (trades; practical skills) and 10-4 (certificate)



Grade 10



- Two Semesters (4 courses per semester)
 - Sept – Jan
 - Feb – June

 8. Option




Grade 11



- Grade 11 – PE is not mandatory; sciences diversify; CALM is required..
- Example Schedule:
 1. ELA
 2. Social Studies
 3. Biology
 4. Physics
 5. Chemistry
 6. Sports Performance
 7. CALM (1/2 a semester; spare)
 8. Math






Grade 12



- Grade 12 – Spares kick in; Math divides into Math 30 and Math Calculus
- Example Schedule:
 1. ELA (REQUIRED for all Universities)
 2. Social Studies
 3. Biology
 4. Physics
 5. Chemistry
 6. Spare
 7. Calculus
 8. Math




High School Registration



- **Step 1:** Confirm High School Designation
 - Students must apply to their designated school
- **Step 2:** Know your High School Path
 - Review school website and attend school Open House
- **Step 3:** Attend Open Houses
- **Step 4:** High School Registration in January
- Please note that some specialized programs have an additional application process – ie. Write an essay

High School Registration



- Course Selection Supports:
 - RTA High School Tour:
 - All students (no matter their HS designation) will attend a January LBHS Tour
 - Several high school guidance counselors come to the school to meet with the students – Lord Beaverbrook High School & Joane Cardinal Shubert
 - JCS often sends a bus to bring students for an afternoon
 - If there are 10 or more students, HS will send a guidance council to meet with a group of students at the school
 - HR teachers will make recommendations
 - You will rank your options according to preference (do not leave any blanks)
 - Some schools have an online registration process, some have a paper registration process.



High School Transfer Process



- *Students must apply to their designated school*
- **Online Transfer Process:** The 2 reasons for transfer:
 1. **To enrol in an education program not offered at the student's designated school** (e.g. International Baccalaureate (IB); Language Programme or Advanced Placement (AP); CBe-learn).
 2. **To take a sequence of courses up to the 30-level that is not offered at the student's designated school** (e.g. cosmetology, welding and fabrication, culinary arts, and auto mechanics).
- **Enrollment Status** (Feb-March):
 - Open, Limited or Closed.
 - You can only choose one program, or one sequence of courses, as the reason for your transfer request.
 - Parents are notified of the decision in early April.
 - No teacher, no parent and no administration letters.
 - Year-to-year based decision
- **NO teacher/principal REFERENCE Letters.**
