Ms Lewis reviewed the Principal's report. Staffing updates are coming in the upcoming WAG. Timetabling - Working to ensure that there is a focus on building community within the school. One of the changes for next year will	

be a PE team dedicated to PE and not having to also teach other classes.

RT Office will open for the new school year on Wednesday August 27th. This is also when teachers will be back in the building.

Bus routes will be available in August. If your family requires busing ensure that you have registered by June 22nd to ensure your student is considered when the routes are made.

School supplies - Most Grade 5&6 school supplies are provided by the school. For Grade 7-9, a school supply list will be provided online. Your student does not need to come to school on the first day with all their supplies.

Classroom placements will be shared around August 28th.
Enrollment numbers are quite fluid until after the summer and as a result classes are not finalized until after the summer break.

Focus the first two weeks of school will be on building the classroom and school community.

New Bell times will be shared in this Friday's week at a glance. With the new school bell times transition breaks have been shortened from 2 min to 1 min and 2 mins have been shaved off lunch hour. There will be a nutrition break added in to Friday from 11:59-12:05 given the later dismissal time of 1pm. Grades 5 & 6 do go out with their classroom for recess.

As a science school, Grade 7 -9 students participate in Career and Technology Foundations (CTF). This is in place of traditional options at standard stream schools. Ms. Lewis reviewed the Clusters that will be offered for each of the grades. The details can be found on the RT website under Teaching & Learning. If a student has chosen to participate in band, they will only participate in half of the clusters offered in a given year.

Discussion from the floor about communications for next year and potential to increase communication from teachers directly to parents. Suggestion to provide review of how to access D2L for families in the fall.

Group Chats - Ms Lewis raised that parents need to be aware of the potential issues with group chats. Many start out as fun ways to connect but the bigger they get the harder they are to manage.

Lindsay asked if Digital Citizenship conversations or guidelines are added to communication to families in the fall during meet the teacher. Ashlin raised that with guest speaker Paul Davis coming in January there will be communication to be shared with the school community in the fall that could be used to further introduce this topic to the school community.
